Grain Bin Lifeline Installation & Use Training March 24 & 25, 2017

DAY 1 - Grain Bin Lifeline Installation & Use (technical course)

Participants will review common causes of entrapment and learn how a lifeline system and other safety strategies protect against entrapment. They will learn the equipment and practice the skills necessary to install and use a secured lifeline system, including anchor points, knots, basic rigging, and belaying techniques. It is recommended participants bring their own safety harness if they have one, as well as any lifeline "kit" or equipment they may have purchased. Participants should wear comfortable, older clothing as they may get soiled or snagged during activities.

DAY 2 - Train the Trainer Component

Do you have a passion for safety? Are you a safety director or do you train others at a commercial facility, farm, or the community?

GHSC invites persons with a passion for safety and/or those in safety or trainer positions to attend the Lifeline Use & Installation Train the Trainer Session. Course will expand on the concepts and skills taught in Day One exploring anchoring techniques further and practicing advanced skills.

High quality curriculum, diverse activities, and experienced instructors will prepare participants to conduct training sessions on Lifeline Installation & Use in their local communities or work places.

A fast-paced learning environment, it is recommended participants have some knowledge of farm or commercial grain handling and storage activities.
